

Fifth Sunday of Easter Jesus is Risen!. Alleluia! Thank you, God, for the gift of your Son!

In the gospel for the 5th Sunday of Easter, we hear Jesus console us, asking us to not let our hearts be troubled because he goes only to prepare a place for us and that "No one comes to the Father except through me."

We need to hold the words of Jesus in our hearts. Their attractive invitation call us to see and experience the life of communion with the Trinity as this life of grace and love is shared with us. As we learn to live in this loving embrace we naturally begin to allow others into this life of communion.

It takes attentiveness to stay focused on this as the foundation of our daily life. We have accumulated multiple distractions over the years. As this consoling message of Jesus finds a place in our conscious awareness at various points in our day, we open ourselves to the mystery of God walking with us. This message moves from being a momentary message on Sunday to the foundation in which all that we do and say and experience is grounded.

"Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on my own. The Father who dwells in me is doing his works. Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else, believe because of the works themselves. Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am going to the Father." John 14
