Sixth Sunday of Easter Jesus is Risen! Alleluia! Thank you, God, for the gift of your Son!

In the liturgy this week, we hear the incredibly comforting news from Jesus: "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you" as he promised to send the Advocate, the Spirit of Truth to us.

The Trinity cannot remain a theological concept in our heads, rather it must move to our hearts. Logically we cannot make sense of three persons in one God, but in our hearts we can fully appreciate belonging in love. Jesus teaches us that the Trinity is the expression of love and identity between him and the Father. It is the Spirit of that love between them that lives in us, directing and supporting our efforts to hear and follow the message of Jesus' life. The power of the Spirit in our lives helps us each day. We are caught up in the intimate relationship he has with the Father.
