**ORDINARY TIME** In the Gospel of this twelfth Sunday of Ordinary time, Jesus tells us not to be afraid and to trust in his love and care for us. In this first full week of summer we have the opportunity to reflect on the calling we have all received. Each of us has a vocation given to us by God, to accomplish a work with our lives for our families and in the community in which we live. As we reflect on the vocation we find ourselves in, the ways we live it and are faithful to it, we can use the days of summer to ask God to strengthen our resolve and to calm all of our fears. May we be comforted by Jesus telling us that fear is what gets in the way of our freedom to be a witness of the Good News for others.

Fear comes in so many forms. Sometimes, when we are angry, or find ourselves to be more and more defensive, we can trace the anxiety or insecurity back to a particular fear or a general fear. How liberating it can be for us to pray for the grace to be fear-less, especially in the concrete ways that will come to us in our everyday life this week.

Father, we come into your presence and ask that you remove all fear from our minds and hearts. You've given us a spirit of power, love, and peace. We approach You reverently and ask for your complete protection. No matter what may come our way, we can do all things with Your help. With St. Paul we proclaim: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Philipians 4: 13


