**NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME** In the readings this Sunday Elijah finds God not in the thunder and driving wind, but in a gentle breeze. In the gospel, Peter's fear gets the best of him, when Jesus calls him out of his boat in a stormy sea. Peter takes his eyes off of Jesus and would have perished without Jesus' rescuing him. In our spiritual lives we learn from Elijah and Peter as they find God in the circumstances in which they find themselves. This week may Mary be our example of balance and faith, walking with God in every moment and trusting in His power to save us even in those times when we cannot see the way to calm, peace and salvation.

Tuesday is the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.**

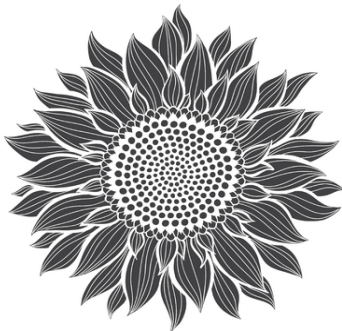
